**Cement Mason Apprentices will be required to furnish the following  
"BAG OF TOOLS":**

- (3) Three trowels (12x4, 12x16, 12x18, varying in size to fit work)
- (1) One pointer (margin trowel)
- (1) One set of coving tools (1 nose & 1 cove)
- (1) One wood hand float (16 x 3 ½ resin or aluminum)
- (1) One rubber float (orange 12 x 4)
- (1) One hammer (18 oz)
- (1) One sledge hammer (8 lbs)
- (1) One hand saw (combination)
- (3) Three hand edgers (1/4", 1/2" & 3/4" radius to match coving tools)
- (1) One set of knee pads
- (1) One set of knee boards
- (1) One hand brush (paint brush)
- (2) Two levels (1 pocket & 1-24" or longer – 48" preferred)
- (1) One pair pliers w/side cutter
- (1) One measuring tape (25')
- (1) One roll nylon cord (300')
- (1) One carpenters pencil
- (1) One marking crayon
- (1) One nail/tool apron

**NOTE: These are the minimum tools required as defined in the Master Labor Agreement and must be obtained immediately upon entering the Northern California Cement Masons Apprenticeship Program.**
